

# BILL & MARNIE DRURY



**STORY:** Bill Drury (1920 - 2009) grew up in Whitehorse and worked for the family business, Taylor & Drury, established by his father William S. Drury and Issac Taylor. Bill would travel with his father to the different outposts where his dad handled the fur trading business with trappers in the area.

Marjorie (Marnie) (1921 - 2011) moved to Whitehorse as a nurse to work at Whitehorse General Hospital. She was an accomplished pianist and painter.

Bill and Marnie married in 1947 and had two children. Bill served as an Alderman on Whitehorse City Council in the 1950's. In 1953 T&D Motors split and Bill operated Yukon Motors until 1970.

Bill's passion for Yukon history resulted in a collection now held by Yukon Archives.

Bill was a founding member of the Yukon Foundation.
