STORY: The Yukon Indian Craft Ltd. established this fund to support the educational needs of children of Indian heritage and to preserve the cultural heritage of the Indian people.

Originally The Yukon Indian Craft Shop was under a board of directors, notably Buz Hudson (judge), Bob Erlam (publisher of the Whitehorse Star), Emma Williams (Kaushee) and her sister Josephine Muff.

Lorraine Joe, a founding member of the Yukon Foundation, bought the business and the contract stipulated that funds from the inventory would be donated to a society for the good of the First Nation people.

Lorraine presented the Foundation with a cheque of the first major donation.
