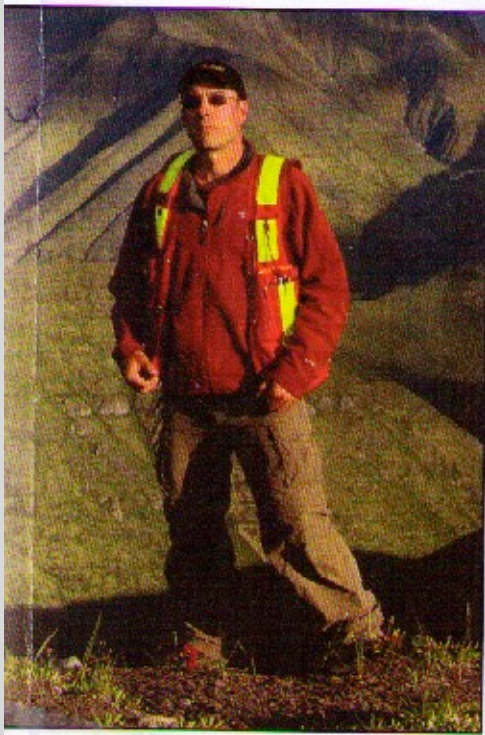


GEOFF BRADSHAW



STORY: Geoff Bradshaw (1974 - 2006) was a mineral assessment geologist with the Yukon Geological Survey. He worked in the territory from 2000 until his death. While conducting field work in the Werneke Mountains, he was killed in a helicopter accident.

Geoff was a hard-working professional who is sadly missed by the geological community.

Geoff was a contributor to both the Ancient Pacific NATMAP project and the Finlayson Lake Project. He completed his Master thesis on the Wolverine massive sulphide deposit in the Finlayson Lake district.
